- Hunting Begins: Noon on Saturday, March 10th
- Weigh-In: Noon on Sunday March 11th
- Entry Fee: \$200 Main Entry Per Team (Teams are Four (4) Members Maximum)
Pays 1st thru 3rd Places (1st 50%, 2nd 30%, 3rd 20% of Entry Fees)
\$ 20 Each Side Pots: Heaviest Bobcat, Coyote, Fox, Raccoon, and
Most Fox (No Cap on Side Pots) (Winner Take All on Side Pots)
- Point System: 100 Pts. Mountain Lion
10 Pts. Red Fox
15 Pts. Bobcat
10 Pts. Coyote
5 Pts. Grey Fox (Max. number is 10/not counted for side pot)
1 Pt. Raccoon
- Contest Rules:
 1. Must Enter Main Entry to Enter Side Pots
 2. No Refunds of Entry Fees After Noon Saturday, March 10th
 3. Maximum Four (4) Members Each Team
 4. All Team Members Must Be Present At Weigh-In on Sunday, March 11th
 5. Land Owner May Be With You, But May Not Participate
 6. No Shooting From or Across a Public Road
 7. Only 10 Animals Per Species Will Count Towards Main Entry
 8. Ties Are Broken With the Total Weight of All Animals
 9. All Animals Must Be Harvested Between Noon Saturday and Noon Sunday
(Animals will be checked for freshness) No Trapped, Snared, Cage-Raised or Frozen Animals Allowed
 10. No Trapped or Snared Animals Accepted/Counted – Anyone Bringing in Such Animals Will Be Disqualified
 11. No Modifying the Weight of Animals in Any Way. No Wet Animals Will Be Weighed/Counted

12. **Teams Call Animals with Hand Calls, Lips Squeaking or Electronics**
13. **No Hunting Baited Areas**
14. **Trolling is Legal (Driving Around While Playing Caller and/or Shining a Light)**
15. **The Use of Any Aircraft or Dogs is Prohibited (Teams May Use a Tracking Dog to Locate a Wounded Animal, But Not to Hunt Animals)**
16. **No Pooling of Animals. Giving, Exchanging or Accepting Any Animal From ANYONE during the Hunt Results in Immediate Team Disqualification and Team Will Be Banned From the Hunt**
17. **Participants May Hunt Anywhere in Texas**
18. **Teams Are Responsible for Their Own Hunting Land During the Hunt**
19. **Teams May Split Up During the Day on the Same Property, But Must Hunt Together At Night Out of the Same Vehicle**
20. **Each Team Is Responsible for Legal Disposal of their Animals**
21. **Each Team Must Follow Texas Dept. of Parks & Wildlife Rules and Guidelines/ Violations of County, State and Federal Hunting Laws Results in Disqualification**
22. **Rules are Subject to Change Without Further Notice From Sponsors and/or Contest Personnel**
23. **The decision of Judges is FINAL. (Judges May NOT Hunt In Contest)**
24. **All Winning Teams Could Be Subject to Polygraph Test.**

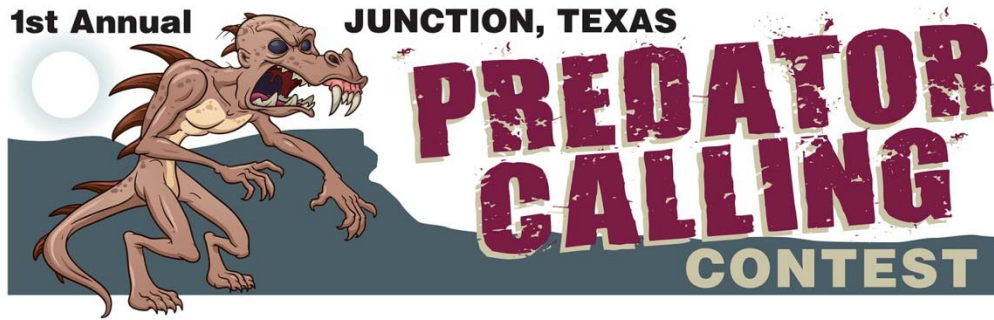
